Winnisquam Regional School District

The Winnisquam Regional School District completed the installation of a biomass heat plant, as well as other energy upgrades throughout the school district. The combination of energy upgrades and retrofits, and the biomass heat plant, are estimated to save the district as much as \$5 million over the next 25 years, and in addition, will allow the school district to have a much lighter impact on the environment. The construction was completed with a combination of financing sources including grants, rebates, ARRA funding, and performance contracting, thereby posing no additional tax burden. In addition to the biomass heating plant for the Middle and High School the project included ventilation upgrades, lighting upgrades, building infiltration reductions, temperature control upgrades, replacement of aging heating and ventilation equipment, and code compliance upgrades.
