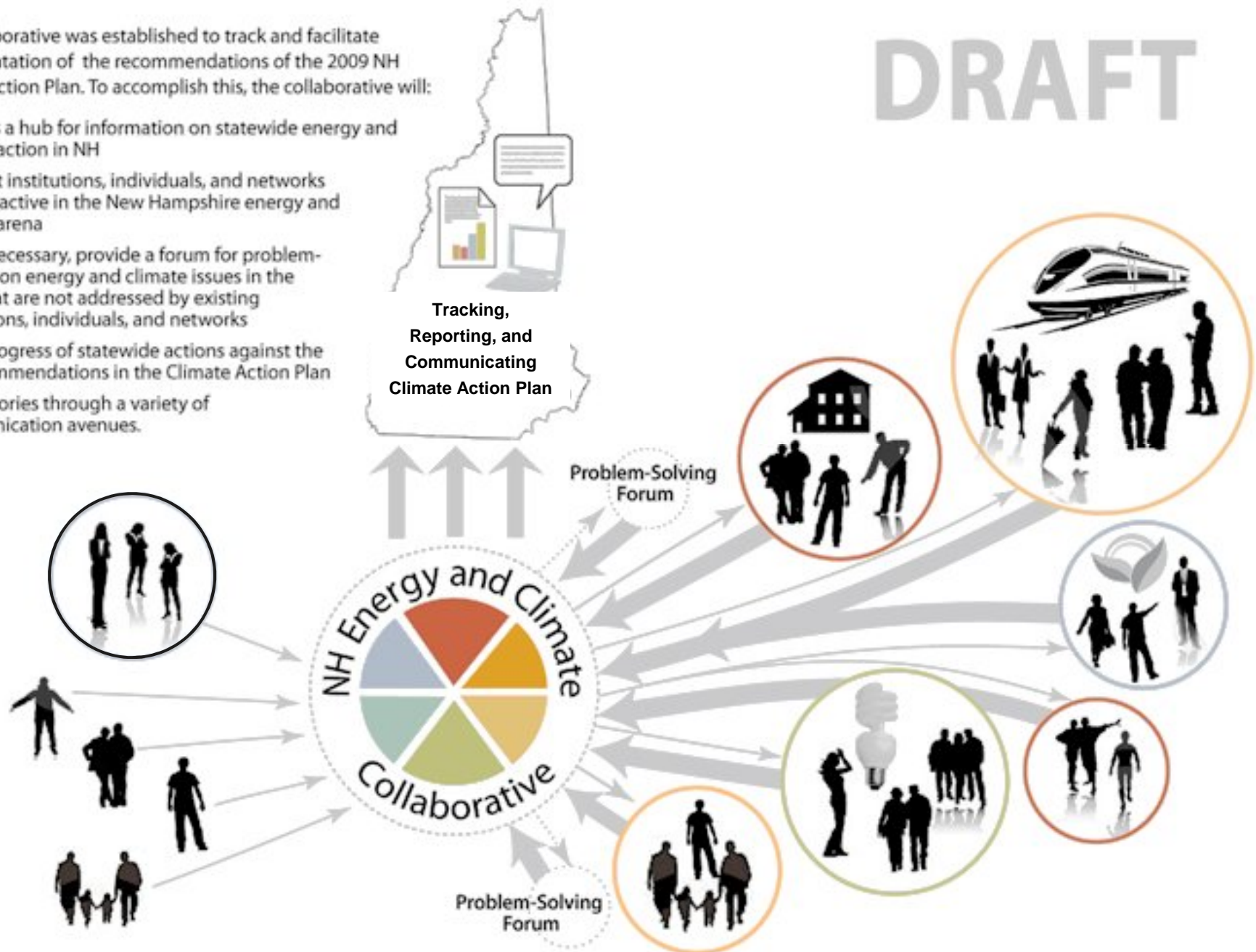

Networks

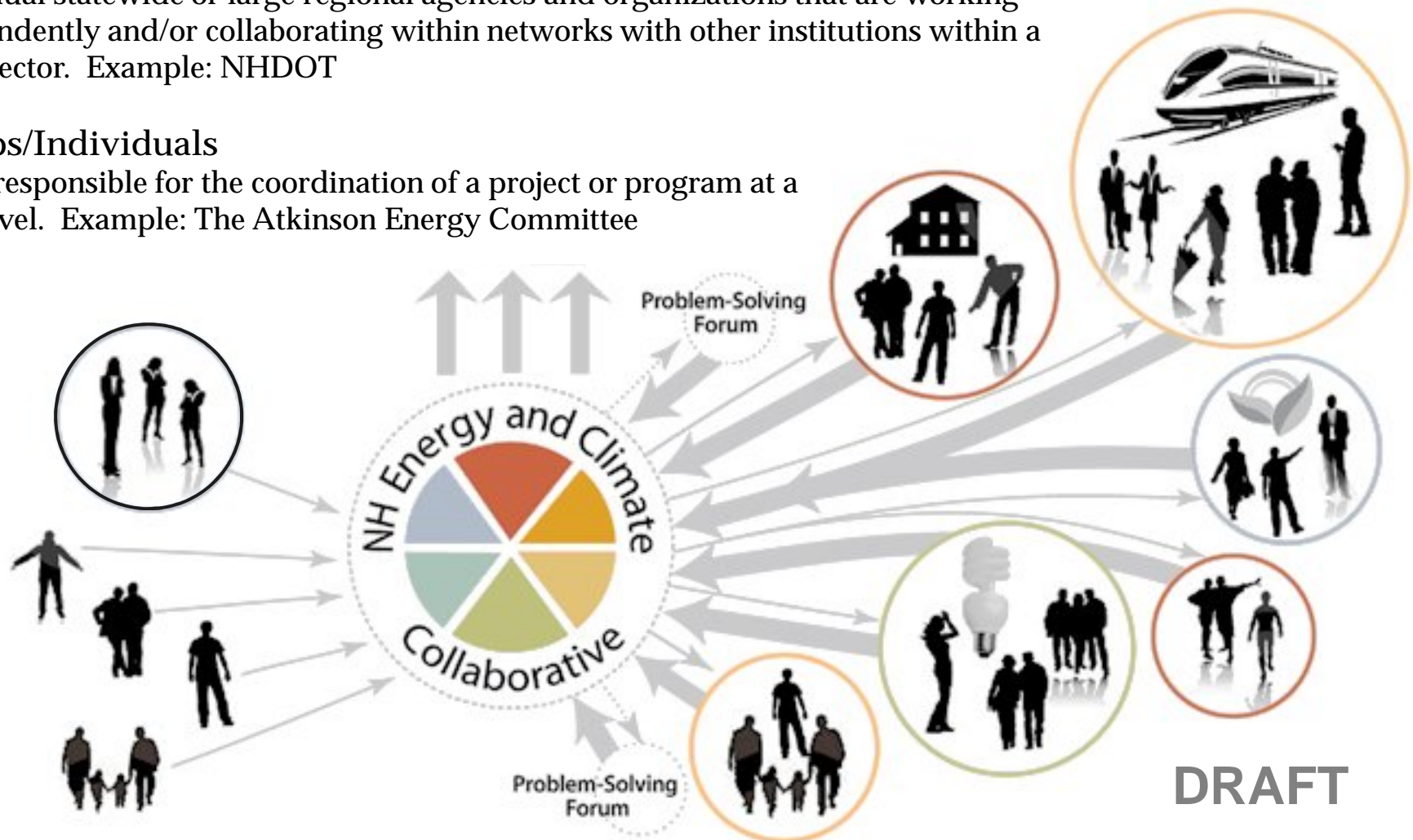
Group of institutions and individuals/actions that are working together on common goals and recommended actions from the Climate Action Plan for a given sector or sectors. Example: EESE Board

Institutions

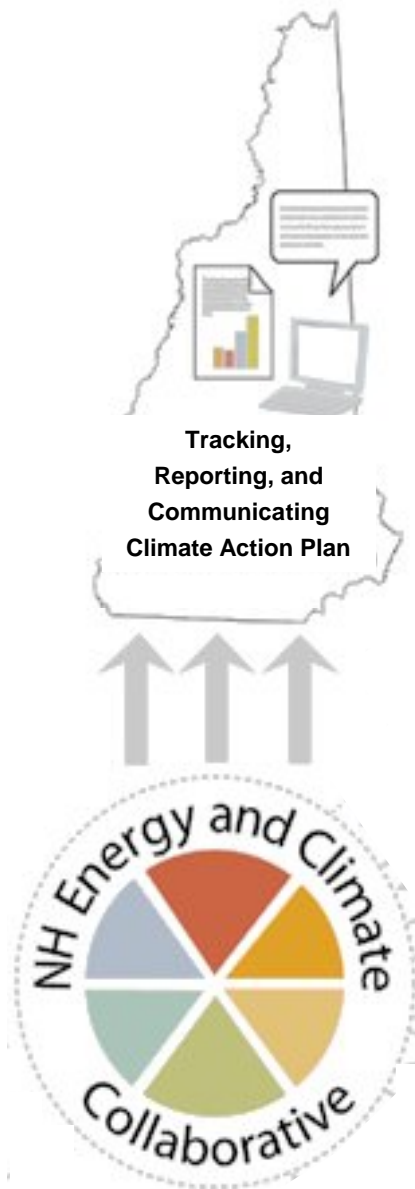
Individual statewide or large regional agencies and organizations that are working independently and/or collaborating within networks with other institutions within a given sector. Example: NHDOT

Groups/Individuals

Entity responsible for the coordination of a project or program at a local level. Example: The Atkinson Energy Committee



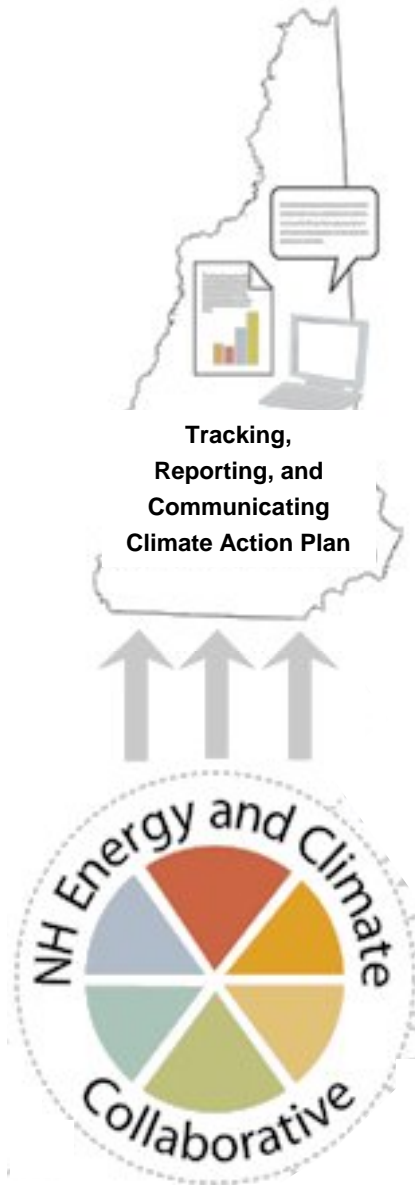
Tracking & Reporting



- Tracking Process:
 - Carbon Reductions for 2012, 2025, and 2050
 - Cost & Benefit and timing of impact of those Cost & Benefits
 - Networks, as defined by the Collaborative Diagram, that are Established, Developing, and Not Yet Established
 - Types of Actions – Education/Communication, Infrastructure, & Process/Planning



Tracking & Reporting



- Inventory of Recommended Actions
 - Tracks who, what, when, opportunities, and barriers
 - Primary Focus for Initial Inventory items in Tracking Process document
 - Welcome input from others on progress for their sector as well

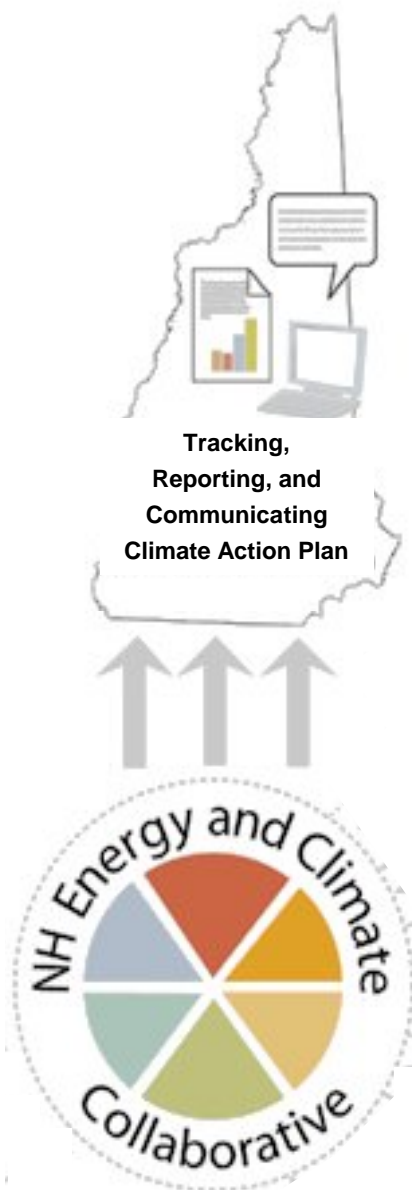


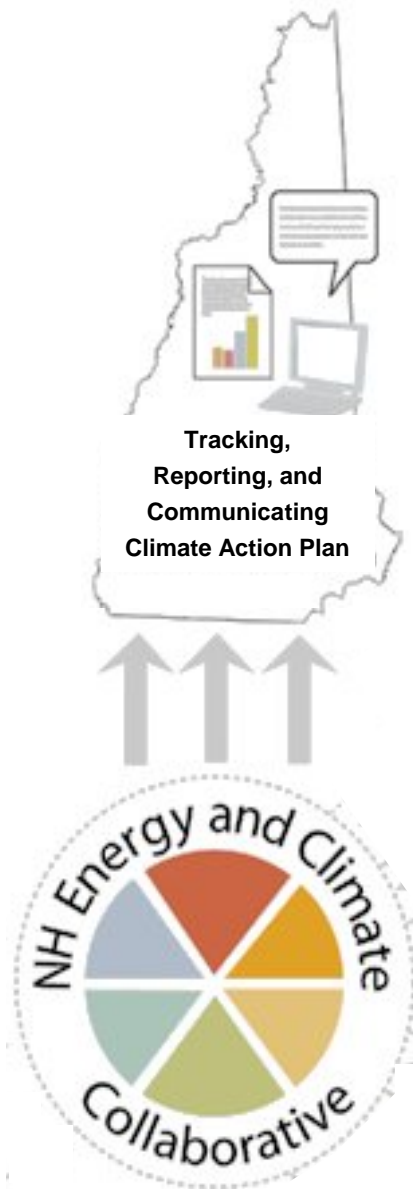

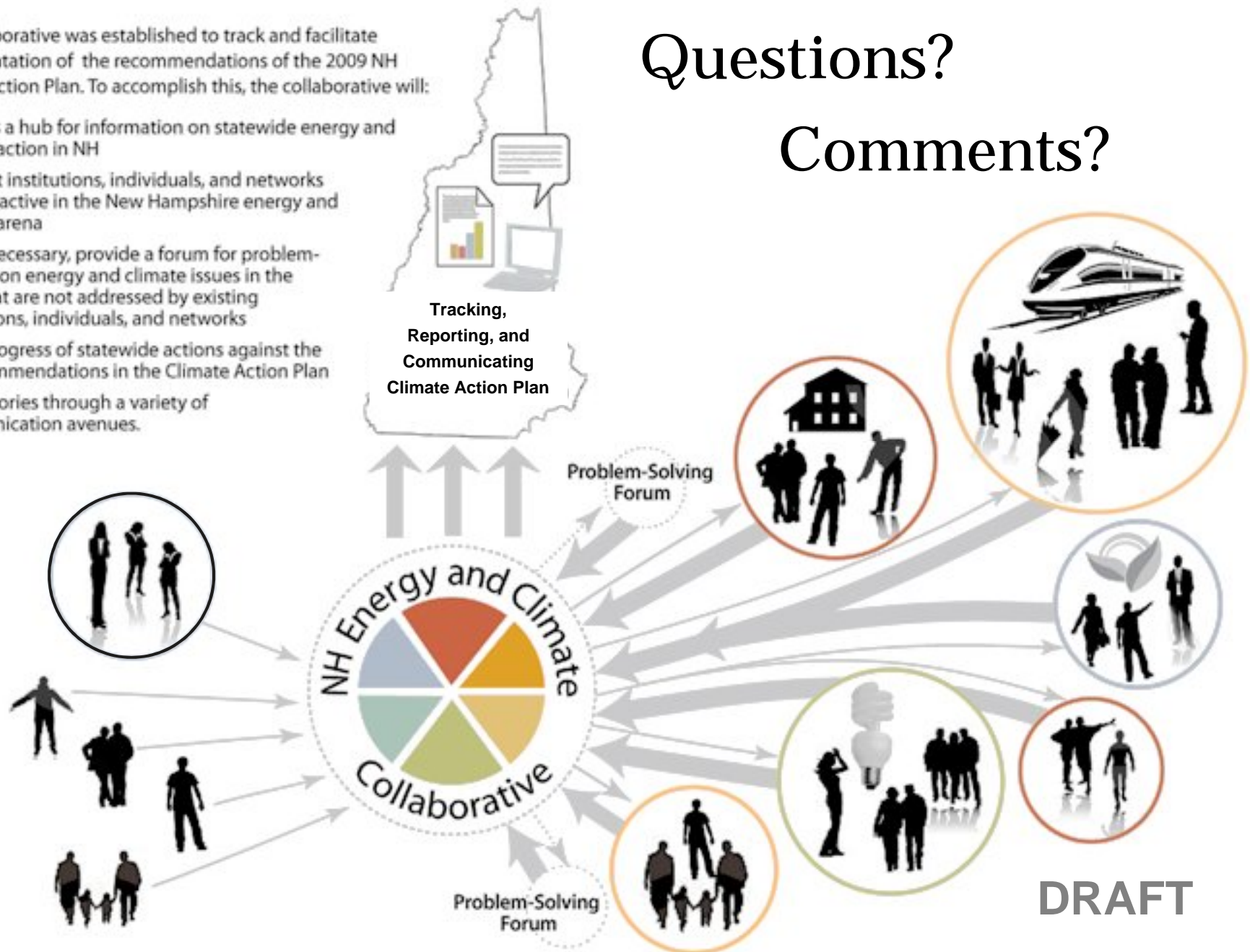
